The Lehigh Valley Planning Commission Comprehensive Planning Committee considered the subject amendments at its April 28, 2015 meeting pursuant to the requirements of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (MPC). The Commission finds that the amendments do not conflict with the County Comprehensive Plan.

Consistent with our comments on February 27, 2015, we suggest including a "Maximum Impervious Coverage" column for all residential zoning districts in addition to the proposed RR and RS district changes. This is for consistency across all residential districts, following a similar convention used for other non-residential zoning districts in the ordinance. Ultimately, the percent coverage is a matter of local concern. The recommendation is simply that a "Maximum Impervious Coverage" exists for all districts in the ordinance.
