No matching funds are required, but the City is required to provide all engineering for this project.



WHEREAS, the applicant desires to receive from the PA Department of Transportation a grant for the purpose of carrying out this project; and

WHEREAS, this project complies with the goals and objectives of the PennDOT Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TASA) in that it improves pedestrian and bicycle safety, complies with all grant guidelines and improves alternative transportation opportunities in a high traffic area in Bethlehem’s urban core.

3. Any amendment to the Grant Agreement may be signed on behalf of the grantee by the Official who, at the time of signing of the amendment, has the TITLE specified in paragraph 1 and the grantee will be bound by the amendment.
