- Letters have been received from PPL and UGI indicating that no easements are required over the portion of Pyatt Street to be vacated.
- A letter has been received from Verizon indicated that they have secured the required easements over the portion of Pyatt Street to be vacated.
- The required Declaration of Covenants has been signed and recorded and a copy provided to the City.
