



COLORS

The color palette is meant to be a subtle range evocative of the tone on tone palettes of colonial vernacular. The blues were anchored on the middle-range blue (PMS 284) used in Moravian College's color palette. The grays are in the cool range, with a continuum from the dove gray of PMS 427 to the almost black shade of PMS 426.





EXTERIOR

The extenor color scheme is meant to tie the four buildings together and create a unified, branded look. Having the lighter gray predominate the upper stones directs the eye to the rich blue facade at street level, hispiration for this look came from several famous bookstores around the world.
