




PROJECT DESCRIPTION

8 East Fourth Street consists of commercial property at the corner of South New Street and East Fourth Street. The commercial space is occupied by Molly's Irish Grille & Sports Pub. The proposed structure will receive façade improvements through a program of the Community Action Development Corporation of Bethlehem. Façade improvements focusing on the awnings and seating enclosure at 12 and 20 E. 4th Street. New awning will include the business logo. This project intends to enhance the aesthetic appeal and highlight the defining historic character of each subject property. Please reference attached sheets for specific details of the project.





MOLLY'S IRISH PUB & SPORTS PUB – Scope of Work 8, 12 &20 East Fourth Street



1.Install new awning above opening at 8 4th Street rear. Awning to be the same configuration as 4th Street elevation (There was an awning at this elevation at some point as fasteners are still on building). Awning fabric to match 4th street awning.

1.Replace existing awning with new fabric on existing frame at 8 4^{th} St. Pattern and color Black Sunbrella fabric with logo and random shamrocks.



1.Install new section of awning on 12 & 20 East 4^{th} St opening between piers. Match existing awning style of 8 East 4^{th} Street.

2. Install 36" high seating enclosure between brick piers of 20 East 4th Street for outdoor seating under building recess. Fabricate welded galvanized pipe frame for fabric panels and attach at pier and sidewalk. I section to return to wall between 20 and 22 E 4th. Fabric panels will be secured by rope lashing at top and bottom rail.

Fabric panels to be of same fabric as awnings. Leave 5' opening centered on entry door of 20 E 4th

1.Replace existing awning with new fabric on existing galvanized frame at 8 4th St. Awning to have open ends. Black Sunbrella fabric with Molly's logo centered on each section of awning. Background will be black. Length 49'-3"





MOLLY'S IRISH PUB & SPORTS PUB – Scope of Work 8, 12 & 20 East Fourth Street



1.Install new awning above opening at 8 4th Street rear. Awning to be the same configuration as 4th Street elevation (There was an awning at this elevation at some point as fasteners are still on building). Length will be 27'-4" Awning fabric to match 4th street awning.

Note: This dimensioned profile is Typical at all awnings. Pipe at bottom of drop. Frame to be 1" welded galvanized pipe. 36" total awning height. NTS

MOLLY'S IRISH PUB & SPORTS PUB – Scope of Work 8, 12 & 20 East Fourth Street

- 1.Install new section of awning on 12 & 20 East 4^{th St} opening between piers. Match existing awning style of 8 East 4th Street. Length 50'-6"
- 2. Install 36" high seating enclosure between brick piers of 20 East 4th Street for outdoor seating under building recess. Fabricate welded 1 1/2" galvanized pipe frame for fabric panels and attach at pier into mortar joints and cover bolts with stainless steel escutcheons. Attach into sidewalk expansion joints, where possible. Cover fasteners with stainless steel sleeve. Number of vertical supports to be determined by awning installer. One section to return to wall between 20 and 22 E 4th for separation of businesses. Fabric panels will be secured by rope lashing through stainless steel grommets at top and bottom rail for ease of removal. Leave 5' opening centered on entry door of 20 E 4th. There will be no logo on these panels. Panels to be of same fabric as awnings. Black Sunbrella Fabric
